

Cookie Program Updates (as of 2/3/25)

- 58% to Council Cookie Program Goal
- 1937 girls in eBudde with sales associated
- 320 troops selling (out of 446)
- Two service units above SU goal (SU 12, Clay County and SU 111, Collinsville)

Toffee update—As we stated in last week's Thin Mint Newsletter, the high volume of Toffee Tastic ordered through initial orders left us with a small amount available to stock cupboards. So, once a cupboard is out, it is out. Troops should monitor their inventory, and if they cannot get more of this variety, they will have to remember to tell their caregivers to turn this off in digital cookies. The Edwardsville Cupboard is already out.

MY25 Membership Goals and Update


Traditional Troop Girls = **5300**; Adults = **3000**
